"WHY THE LORD'S TABLE?"

An Overview



Selected Scripture

SUNDAY

This week continue our study of The Lord's Supper (Communion). We begin this week with just an overview and will learn more details later on. We pray that this study will be a great benefit and encouragement to you!

Read: Matthew 26:26-30 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, Help me to understand the significance of the Lord's Table.

MONDAY

We are going to answer the following questions about the Lord's Table: What does it mean? Who should participate and who should not? How can the Lord's Table become a form of idolatry? What is the picture of community in the Lord's Table? Etc... Think about these questions and see if you know the answer to each one.

Read: Luke 22:14-23 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, I thank You for the ordinance of the Lord's Table and what it is to remind me of.

TUESDAY

There has always been a lot of confusion about the Lord's Table. Some people neglect it, some misunderstand it, some exalt it to a position it was never meant for, and some turn it into an idol. The Lord's Table was ordained to be a continual remembrance of the sacrificial death of Jesus Christ and the benefits that we receive from it.

Read: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, I thank You for the sacrifice of Your body and the shedding of Your blood to save undeserving sinners like me.

WEDNESDAY

As we read in yesterday's verses, the Lord's Table is a time when the true believer is brought to focus solely on the death of Jesus Christ in his place and as his substitute. It is a time of remembrance and recollection of what He did.

Read: Hebrews 10:1-25 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, I thank You for Your great sacrifice!

THURSDAY

When Jesus took the bread and wine in His hand and said, "This is my body and blood," the disciples knew that He was using them as a symbol. They were not actually eating and drinking His physical body and blood. That would be impossible! Jesus preached about this in the book of **John** before the Lord's Supper even took place.

Read: John 6:41-58 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, Help me understand the significance of being joined to Christ by faith.

FRIDAY

The Lord's Table was so important to the early Christians that they came together to celebrated it almost every day! The Lord's Table reminds true believers of the time their eyes were opened and were saved by Jesus Christ. It brings them back to "square one".

Read: Acts 2:38-42 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, I am thankful that I can have fellowship with You and Your people.

SATURDAY

The Scripture tells us that we are to examine ourselves before we celebrate the Lord's Table and see if there is any unconfessed sin in our hearts. Take a look at your own heart today and see if there is anything that you need to confess to God and prepare yourself ahead of time for the Lord's Table tomorrow.

Read: 1 Corinthians 11:27-32 -What principles in these verses can I apply to my life today?

Prayer Starter: Lord, Examine my heart and reveal any sin that I need to confess to You.
