"THE TRAGEDY OF HEARING ONLY"



Ezekiel 33:30-33

THE LORD'S DAY

<u>Read</u>: This week we take a break from our study of Mark to do some selfevaluation. We are going back to the Old Testament to learn about a prophet named Ezekiel. Read **Ezekiel 33:30-33** and ask God to help you understand His Word this week.

Prayer Starter: Dear God, help me to learn from Your Word.

<u>MONDAY</u>

<u>Read</u>: The prophet Ezekiel was chosen by God to deliver a message to the Israelites who had been exiled. There were many "false prophets" there who were telling the people they would soon be free. Ezekiel's message was not as encouraging, but it was the truth. Read **Ezekiel 1:28-2:9** to find out what God instructed him to.

Prayer Starter: Dear God, Help me to obey You.

TUESDAY

<u>Read</u>: God prepares Ezekiel to deliver the message by asking him to do something unusual. Read **Ezekiel 3:1-15** to find out what it was. God wanted him to do this so that he would understand the importance of delivering God's message even if it would not be accepted by the people. The message was "sweet" because it contained God's Word, but it was also "bitter" because it contained judgment. Read **Jeremiah 15:16** and **Revelation 10:9-10** to find out about two other men who had to do the same thing.

Prayer Starter: Dear God, Thank You for Your Word.

WEDNESDAY

<u>Read</u>: Ezekiel delivered God's message as God instructed even though he knew the people wouldn't like it. The Elders of our church are very similar to Ezekiel in that they must deliver God's message to us every week. Sometimes it is "sweet" (pleasant) and sometimes it is "bitter" (harsh), but whatever God's message is, we must listen to it <u>and</u> obey. We need to take the Bible seriously and realize that everything we learn from it is for our own good even if it seems harsh. <u>Prayer Starter</u>: Dear God, Help me to listen to those who teach me Your Word and help me to obey.

THURSDAY

<u>Read</u>: In **Ezekiel 33:30-33** we find out that the people were hearing God's message but had no intentions of obeying it. They were all talking about Ezekiel. They heard and were intrigued by what he had to say because they knew it was from God, but that was it. They never obeyed. Read Luke 23:8, Acts 24:22-27, & Acts 26:24-29 to find out about some others who were intrigued by God's message but never obeyed it.

Prayer Starter: Dear God, Help me to hear Your Word and obey it.

FRIDAY

<u>Read</u>: In verse 31 God says the people who listened only pursued their "own gain". In verse 32 God says they "enjoy" listening to the prophet but they only hear and do not act. In verse 33 God says there will come a day when they will realize that the message was true but it will be too late. Read James 1:22-25. See what else God says about hearing only.

Prayer Starter: Dear God, Help me to be a "doer" of the Word.

SATURDAY

<u>Read</u>: Think about what we learned this week about "hearers only". This world we live in tells us our life should be all about "Our Brains, Our Bodies, and Our Bank Accounts". Read **Jeremiah 9:23-24** to find out what God says life is all about. Pursue God above everything else, know Him more than anyone else, and obey Him at every opportunity.

Prayer Starter: Dear God, Help me to obey You and Your Word.
